His main areas of research are modern South Asia and the history of the Indian Ocean region. Among his many publications are *Modern South Asia: History, Culture, Political Economy* (Routledge, 2004; with Ayesha Jalal), *A Hundred Horizons: The Indian Ocean in the Age of the Global Empire* (Harvard, 2006) and *The Essential Writings of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose* (Oxford, 1999). Professor Bose grew up in Calcutta where he attended Presidency College. He earned his Ph.D in History from Cambridge University.
