The Association of Sri Lankan Sociologists invites submissions for the International Conference on Socio-political and Cultural Dimensions of Reconciliation in Sri Lanka to be held on 6th and 7th May 2016 in Colombo, Sri Lanka.

The conference will be an excellent platform for academics, practitioners, policy planners and other interested scholars to discuss their research and ideas on reconciliation in Sri Lanka under the sub-themes of education, language issues, religion and culture, employment policy, youth identity, regional development, state structure and national reconciliation, and national policy on reconciliation.

The work to be presented should be either based on rigorous empirical research or a thorough conceptual analysis based on critical review of relevant literature.

Abstracts will be reviewed by a panel of reviewers and should conform to the format given below:

1. Brief title not exceeding 50 characters
2. Maximum 300 words
3. Include the following – research issue, methodology, data analysis, and conclusion
4. Up to 4 key words
5. Authors name, affiliation and contact details

Deadline for submission of abstracts is 15th February 2016 and decisions will be made by 1st March 2016. Final papers are due by 15th April 2016.
