## **Teaching Urdu as a Second Language Training Program in the US** **Deadline: January 20, 2017**

### **Description:**

The Berkeley Urdu Language Program in Pakistan (BULPIP) and the American Institute of Pakistan Studies (AIPS) invite applications from individuals interested in undertaking Urdu as a second language teacher's training in the United States in the summer of 2017. The appointment is for a portion of the SASLI Urdu program at the University of Wisconsin in Madison (June 5- July 2, 2017) and a three-day workshop held at University of Texas, Austin (July 5-7, 2017).

### **Outcomes:**

#### **By the end of the program the Urdu Lecturer will be expected to:**

- Create and teach a beginning course in Urdu as a second language;
- Create and teach an intermediate course in Urdu as a second language;
- Those who successfully complete the program will be eligible to apply later for a 1 semester/quarter placement at a US-based university to deepen their training as a teacher of Urdu as a second language.

### **Requirements and Qualifications:**

- This program is only open to Urdu teachers based in Pakistan with demonstrated experience teaching Urdu language classes at the college or university level;
- Fluency in Urdu and English;
- An M.A. in Urdu language or literature, Linguistics, or a related field is desired but not required.

### **Application Process:**

- A letter of application—copies in both Urdu and English—clearly stating how such a program fits in your past, present and future goals;
- A current Curriculum Vitae;
- Samples of relevant teaching materials authored by the applicant;
- Teaching evaluations (if available);

**Compensation:**

- Airfare to and from the United States;
- Housing in Madison and Austin for the duration of the Teaching Urdu as Second Language Training Program;
- Weekly stipend (in US dollars) through the duration of the Teaching Urdu as a Second Language Training Program.
