




Girangaon : Village of the Mills



This neighborhood was at the center of the evolution of Bombay city as a modern metropolis



















The social and cultural life was a mixture of the local Marathi culture and the cosmopolitan Progressive instincts of the world over




The mixed zoning of the neighbourhood was one of the important reasons for a large percentage of women employed in the textile industry.
